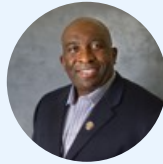

BEC - FBI CALLS IT THE \$43B* HEIST. HOW TO TAME THIS BEAST?



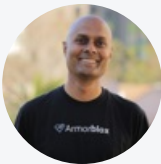

According to the FBI's recent IC3 report in 2022, exposed business loss due to BEC accounts for > \$43B. Why? 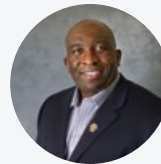
