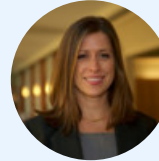

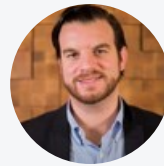

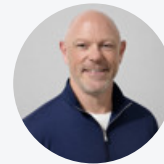

Always Advancing: Ransomware, AI and the Next Wave of Cyber Attacks

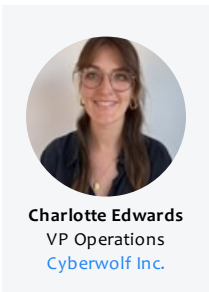
