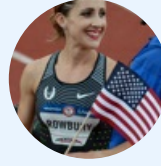

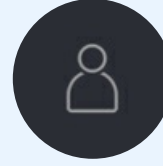

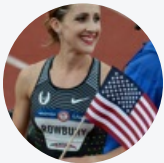

Developing a passion for the underlying work

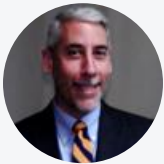
Having a job where you make meaningful contributions to society

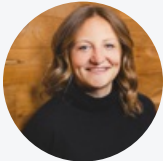

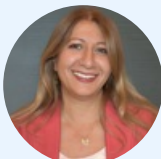
